Re: Landmark Legal Foundation Request for Investigation


Dear Mr. Beckhard:

On April 25, 2017, Landmark Legal Foundation submitted a detailed request for investigation into whether Justice Department officials improperly leaked classified information gathered pursuant to warrants authorized by the United States Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court. Landmark submitted a supplemental complaint on July 25, 2017. Each of these complaints detailed multiple published reports citing “confidential” Department of Justice officials who illegally leaked classified information.

On June 20, 2017, the Office of Inspector General Investigations Division wrote that Landmark would be contacted regarding the complaint’s status “in the near future.” Landmark has received no further contact.

Accordingly, I respectfully request an update on the status of Landmark’s complaint. The intervening months since the complaint’s submission have seen continuing leaks from Department of Justice officials. It is imperative that the Oversight and Review Division act immediately to investigate this critical matter of national importance.
